



## Promoting Fundamental British Values as part of S.M.S.C.

The DfE have continued to reinforce the need “to create and enforce a clear and rigorous expectation on all schools to promote the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.”

The government set out its definition of British values in the 2011 Prevent Strategy, and these values have been reiterated by the Prime Minister and other Politicians on a number of occasions. At Low Moor CE Primary School, these values are reinforced regularly and in the following ways:
